## FUNDING FOR PROJECTS ON YOUR LAND

### Do you have....?

- **a stream, lakeshore, wetland or pond where livestock are watering?**  
(Funding is available for fencing, alternate watering sources, planting a buffer)
- **an erosion problem along a lakeshore or river leading to a lake in the Kawarthas?**  
(Funding is available for erosion control)
- **a wetland or stream crossing that needs improvement for agricultural purposes?**  
(Funding is available for crossing construction)
- **a low area that you would like to restore as a wetland?**  
(Funding is available for construction, planting and fencing)
- **a cropped field with a stream or ditch that is silting in?**  
(Funding is available for buffer plantings to help reduce erosion  
NOTE: this funding is not for installing tile drainage)
- **a tree planting project?**  
(We can help plan and plant trees and shelterbelts)
